Our office follows infection control recommendations made by the American Dental Association, the U.S. Centers for Disease Control (CDC), and the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA).

- We will do our best to allow greater time between patients to reduce waiting times for you, as well as to reduce the number of patients in the office at any one time.
